Q. 1. B-Grammar- It carries 5 marks based on Grammar (Match the columns)

Q.2. to 6- Prose- They will be Short Answer type questions from Prose section of Text Book. Each question carries 2 marks. Word limit- 30.

Q.7. Data Analysis- It will be a Short Answer type analytical question that carries 3 marks. It is from Study Skill. (Text Book) Word limit- 40

Q. 8. Poster with Slogan- It will be a Short Answer type question that carries 3 marks, based on Poster making with Slogan. Word limit-40

Q. 9. Notice Writing- It will be a Long Answer type question that carries 4 marks, based on Notice Writing. Word limit- 50 words.

Q.10. Summarization- It will be a Long Answer type question that carries 4 marks, based on Summary Writing. Word limit- 50 words.

Q.11, Data Analysis- It will be a Long Answer type question that carries 4 marks, based on Data Analysis. (Table/Graph/Chart) Word limit- 50 words.

Q. 12. Poetry - It will be a Long Answer type evaluative question from Poetry. It carries 4 marks with internal choice. (and 2 questions to be attempted out of 3. Word limit- 30.


Q.13. Grammar -It will be a Long Answer type question based on Grammar that carries 5 marks. (Any 5 questions to be attempted out of 7) (1x5) VSA.

Q.14. Seen Passage- It will be a Seen passage that carries 5 marks. (1x5) VSA.

Q. 15. Unseen Passage- It will be an Unseen passage that carries 5 marks. (1x5) VSA.

Q. 16. Letter Writing- It will be a Long Answer type question that carries 5 marks based on Letter writing. Word limit- 60.

Q 17. Essay Writing -It will be a Very Long Answer type question that carries 8 marks, based on Essay Writing. Word limit-150-200.
